



## Documents Needed for the FAFSA (Financial Aid)

- W-2 Forms and any other records of money earned
  - You will need records of income earned in the year prior to when you will start school. If you are a dependent student, you will need your parents' income information.
- Federal Income Tax Return
  - IRS Form 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ
  - Foreign tax return, or Tax return for Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, or Palau
  - For dependent students, bring your parents' records.
  - For independent students, bring your records and your spouse's records (if you are married).
- Untaxed Income Records
  - Social Security
  - Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
  - Welfare
  - Veterans benefits records
- Current Bank Statements (if applicable)
- Social Security Card
- Driver's License (if applicable)
- Alien Registration or Permanent Residence Card (if you are not a U.S. Citizen)
